
Formal commencement of claim

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Rules as follows:

On 22 June 2022, the AEMC received notification of a claim for compensation under clause 3.14.6 from Origin Energy following the application of the administered price cap during an administered price period in Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and South Australia between 12 June 2022 and 22 June 2022.

Origin Energy is claiming compensation for direct costs only incurred in operating Roma Power Station and Mt Stuart Power Station during the administered price period.

Origin Energy provided information in support of its claim on 04/08/2022.

The AEMC is reasonably satisfied that it has sufficient information from Origin Energy to assess the claim and has now commenced formal assessment of the claim. The timeframes provided in clauses 3.14.6(I) to (s) of the National Electricity Rules will now apply to this claim for compensation.
