
Formal commencement of claim

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Rules as follows:

On 22 June 2022 and 29 June 2022, the AEMC received notifications of a claim for compensation under clause 3.14.6 from Aurora Energy (Tamar Valley) Pty Ltd trading as AETV following the application of the administered price cap during an administered price period in Queensland, New South Wales, South Australia and Victoria between 12 June 2022 and 23 June 2022.

Aurora Energy (Tamar Valley) Pty Ltd trading as AETV is claiming compensation for direct costs only incurred in operating Bairnsdale Power Station unit 1 (BDL01) during the administered price period.

Aurora Energy (Tamar Valley) Pty Ltd trading as AETV provided information in support of its claim on 1 August 2022.

The AEMC is reasonably satisfied that it has sufficient information from Aurora Energy (Tamar Valley) Pty Ltd trading as AETV to assess the claim and has now commenced formal assessment of the claim. The timeframes provided in clauses 3.14.6(I) to (s) of the National Electricity Rules will now apply to this claim for compensation.
