

National Electricity Amendment (Rescheduling the generator compliance programs review) Rule 2024 No. 21

The Australian Energy Market Commission makes the following Rule under the National Electricity Law to the extent applied by:

- (a) the *National Electricity (South Australia) Act 1996* of South Australia;
- (b) the *Electricity (National Scheme) Act 1997* of the Australian Capital Territory;
- (c) the *Electricity National Scheme (Queensland) Act 1997* of Queensland;
- (d) the *National Electricity (New South Wales) Act 1997* of New South Wales;
- (e) the *Electricity National Scheme (Tasmania) Act 1999* of Tasmania;
- (f) the National Electricity (Victoria) Act 2005 of Victoria;
- (g) the National Electricity (Northern Territory) (National Uniform Legislation) Act 2015 of the Northern Territory; and
- (h) the Australian Energy Market Act 2004 of the Commonwealth.

1 Title of Rule

This Rule is the *National Electricity Amendment (Rescheduling the generator compliance programs review) Rule 2024 No. 21.*

2 Commencement

This Rule commences operation on 5 December 2024.

3 Savings and Transitional Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

The National Electricity Rules are amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Savings and Transitional Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

(Clause 3)

[1] New Rule 11.178 National Electricity Amendment (Rescheduling the generator compliance programs review) Rule 2024 No. 21

In Chapter 11, after rule 11.177, insert:

11.178 National Electricity Amendment (Rescheduling the generator compliance programs review) Rule 2024 No. 21

- (a) Despite clause 8.8.3(ba), and subject to paragraph (b), the *Reliability Panel* is not required to conduct or commence its conduct of a review of the *template for generator compliance programs* by 19 December 2024.
- (b) The *Reliability Panel* must commence the conduct of its next review of the *template for generator compliance programs* by 19 December 2025.

Note

The last review of the *template for generator compliance programs* was completed by the *Reliability Panel* on 19 December 2019.
