Under s 251, The Hon Chris Bowen MP, Minister for Climate Change and Energy, as Chair of the Energy and Climate Change Ministerial Council has requested the *Removing unreasonable conditional discounts* (Ref. RRC0065) proposal. The proposal seeks to remove the grandfathering arrangement in the *National Energy Retail Amendment (Regulating conditional discounting) Rule 2020 No. 1* to ensure that any conditional fees or discounts are limited to reasonable costs for those contracts in force prior to 1 July 2020. Submissions must be received by **16 January 2025.**
