This dashboard shows the progress towards emissions targets and shares of renewable energy

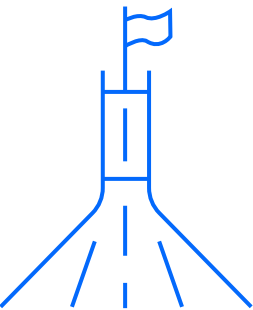

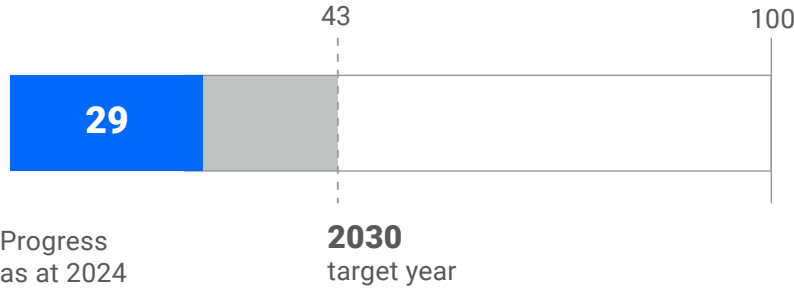


**Renewables progress** is shown as the percentage of total electricity generation that is derived from renewables sources. Data from Australian Energy Statistics for 2024 calendar year.

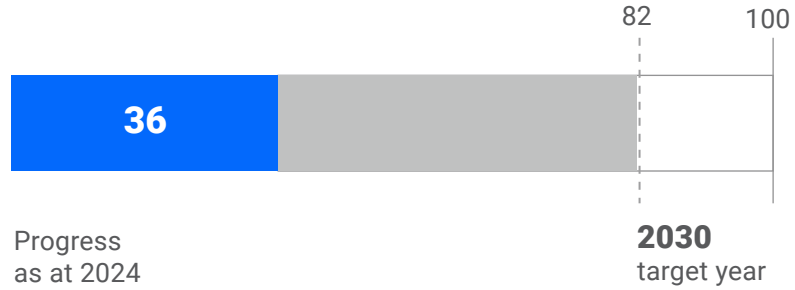
