Re: Revocation of Parts 10 and 24 National Gas Rules exemptions for three pipelines

I refer to the 16 December 2025 applications, by AGL Gas Storage Pty Ltd (**AGL**), for revocation of exemptions for the Churchie Pipeline, Silver Springs to Wallumbilla Pipeline and Waggamba Pipeline under Parts 10 and 24 of the National Gas Rules (**NGR**).

On 6 February 2026, the AER decided to accept AGL's application to revoke NGR Part 10 and 24 exemptions, for these three pipelines, on the basis that AGL is no longer the responsible service provider since transferring ownership of the pipelines to OGT Energy Pty Ltd.¹

The AER is required to establish, publish and maintain a register of exemptions and revocations under Parts 10 and 24 of the NGR. The NGR Part 10 and 24 exemptions for the three pipelines will be updated on the AER's exemptions registers to reflect these revocation decisions.
