Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Australian Energy Market Commission's additional consultation on specific issues related to the expanding competition in metering and related services proposed amendments.

I am pleased to see that the Commission has given further consideration to two of the issues raised by the Energy Markets and Programs Division (the Division) in its previous submission, namely a lack of options available to the metering coordinator where a customer refuses a new advanced meter and the allocation of liabilities and responsibilities associated with informing customers of planned and unplanned interruptions.
