NATIONAL ELECTRICITY RULES AMENDMENT AGGREGATION OF ANCILLARY SERVICE LOADS DRAFT DETERMINATION

Aurora Energy Tamar Valley (AETV) is pleased to provide the following submission in response to the Australian Energy Market Commission's (AEMC) draft Rule change determination of 24 June proposed by the Australian Energy Market Operator.

The Rule change seeks to remove barriers to the aggregation of ancillary service loads for provision of market ancillary services.

AETV is a market generator and owns and operates the Tasmanian Tamar Valley Power Station, which is a fully owned subsidy of Aurora Energy Pty Ltd.
