


Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under s 107, the time for making the draft determination on the *Retailer insolvency costs – pass through provisions* proposal has been extended to **18 February 2016**.

Under ss 102 and 103, the making of the *National Electricity Amendment (Early application of STPIS components to transmission businesses) Rule 2015 No. 1* and related final determination. All provisions commence on **19 February 2015**.

Under s 93(1)(a), the *Demand management incentive scheme* rule request proposed by the Total Environment Centre has been consolidated with the *Demand management and embedded generation connection incentive scheme* rule request proposed by the Council of Australian Governments' Energy Council.

Under s 95, the consolidated *Demand management incentive scheme* rule request has been initiated (Ref. ERC0177). The consolidated rule request seeks to reform the demand management incentive scheme under Chapter 6 of the National Electricity Rules (NER). Submissions must be received by **19 March 2015**.
