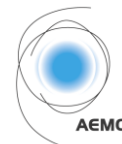


# Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under s 95, the Australian Energy Regulator has requested the *Generator ramp rates and dispatch inflexibility in bidding* proposal (Ref. ERC0165). The proposal seeks to require generators to submit ramp rates and dispatch inflexibility profiles that reflect the technical capabilities of generating plant. Submissions must be received by **27 March 2014**.

Under s 107, the time for making the draft determination on the *Generator ramp rates and dispatch inflexibility in bidding* proposal has been extended to **28 August 2014**.

Submissions can be made via the AEMC's website. Before making a submission, please review the AEMC's privacy statement on its website. Submissions should be made in accordance with the AEMC's *guidelines for making written submissions on Rule change proposals*. The AEMC publishes all submissions on its website, subject to confidentiality.
