1 Title of Rule

Schedule 1 Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

(Clause 3)

[1] Clause 6A.6.5 Efficiency benefit sharing scheme

In clause 6A.6.5(b)(2), omit "and" where lastly occurring.

[2] Clause 6A.6.5 Efficiency benefit sharing scheme

In clause 6A.6.5(b)(3), omit "." and substitute:

- (4) the possible effects of the scheme on incentives for the implementation of non-*network* alternatives.
