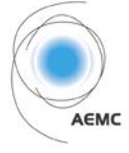


Notice under National Energy Retail Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Energy Retail Law as follows:

Under s 251, COAG Energy Council has requested the rule change *Improving the accuracy of customer transfers* (Ref. RRC0007). The proposal seeks to improve the experience of small customers when transferring to new electricity or gas retailers. Submissions must be received by **9 June 2016**.

Under s 251, COAG Energy Council has requested the rule change *Using estimated reads for customer transfers* (Ref. RRC0008). The proposal seeks to reduce the time it takes small customers to transfer to a new retailer by allowing customers with manually-read meters to transfer based on an estimated meter read. Submissions must be received by **9 June 2016**.

Submissions should be made in accordance with the AEMC's *Guidelines for making written submissions on rule change proposals*.
