

Notice of Second Draft Report



Electricity and Gas Retail Competition Review in South Australia

The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) has published the Second Draft Report in its review of the effectiveness of competition in the electricity and gas retail markets in South Australia, in accordance with the Request for Advice received from the Ministerial Council on Energy. The Second Draft Report sets out the AEMC's draft advice that the existing framework for regulating retail energy prices in South Australia should be replaced by transparent price monitoring and reporting, and the ability to re-introduce price regulation if competition deteriorates.

Submissions to the Second Draft Report must be received by **17 November 2008**. Submissions should be forwarded to submissions@aemc.gov.au and in accordance with any other requirements set out in the Second Draft Report. The AEMC publishes all submissions on its website subject to a claim of confidentiality.
