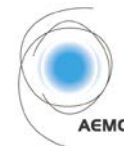


Notice under National Electricity Law



The Australian Energy Market Commission (AEMC) gives notice under the National Electricity Law as follows:

Under section 93(1)(a), the *System Restart Ancillary Services* request proposed by AEMO has been consolidated with the *System Restart Ancillary Services* request proposed by the National Generators Forum, AGL, Alinta Energy, Energy Brix Australia, GDF SUEZ, Intergen and Origin.

Under s 95, the consolidated *System Restart Ancillary Services* proposal (Ref. ERC0168). The proposal seeks to address issues concerning the economic basis for System Restart Ancillary Services, together with the associated governance, procurement and cost recovery arrangements. Submissions must be received by **8 May 2014**.

Under s 107, the time for making the draft determination on the *System Restart Ancillary Services* proposal has been extended to **28 August 2014**.
