Draft National Electricity Amendment Generating System Model Guidelines



Vestas would like to reiterate the following comments in line with our submission on the consultation paper:

- EMT model requirement should be determined on a case by case basis and not as a general requirement for every project.
- Where there is a need, EMT model will be provided for PSCAD software in an encrypted (blackbox) format only with a Non Disclosure Agreement (NDA) signed between Vestas and AEMO. No source code and/or block diagram will be available for EMT models.
- If AEMO wishes to share any EMT models or related information with third parties, they need to inform Vestas and the third party must sign a separate NDA with VESTAS. AEMO may not hand over or disclose any EMT models or related information to any third parties.
