National Electricity Amendment (Delayed implementation of five minute and global settlement) Rule 2020 No. 10

1 Title of Rule

This Rule is the *National Electricity Amendment (Delayed implementation of five minute and global settlement) Rule 2020 No. 10*.

2 Commencement

This Rule commences operation on 9 July 2020.

[9] Clause 2 Commencement of National Electricity Amendment (Participant compensation following market suspension) Rule 2018

In clause 2 of the *National Electricity Amendment (Participant compensation following market suspension) Rule 2018 No. 13*, omit "1 July 2021" and substitute "1 October 2021".

[10] Clause 2 Commencement of National Electricity Amendment (Minor changes) Rule 2020

In clause 2 of the *National Electricity Amendment (Minor changes) Rule 2020 No. 3*, omit "6 February 2022" and substitute "1 May 2022".

Note: Commencement 1 October 2021

In clause 11.103.1, insert the following new definition in alphabetical order:

old commencement date means 1 July 2021.

[4] Clause 11.103.2 Amendments to procedures

In clause 11.103.2(a), insert "old" before "commencement".

In clause 11.103.2(d), insert "old" before "commencement".

[2] Clause 11.112.1 Definitions

In clause 11.112.1, omit the definition of **effective date** and substitute:

effective date means 1 May 2022.

[3] Clause 11.112.1 Definitions

In clause 11.112.1, insert the following new definition in alphabetical order:

old effective date means 6 February 2022.

[4] Clause 11.112.2 Amendments to AEMO procedures

In clause 11.112.2(a), insert "old" before "effective date".

[5] Clause 11.112.3 AEMO to publish report on unaccounted for energy trends

In clause 11.112.3(a), omit "1 March 2022" and substitute "1 June 2022".

[6] Clause 11.112.5 Publication of UFE data by AEMO

In clause 11.112.5(a), omit "1 July 2021" and substitute "1 October 2021".

[7] Clause 11.112.6 Publication of UFE reporting guidelines

In clause 11.112.6(a), omit "1 December 2022" and substitute "1 March 2023".
