Comments: I am totally opposed to paying for the input of my own generated solar power to the grid. The proposition that a producer of any good would pay to sell their product to the market is preposterous. My solar power system including 1 5kw inverter, 18 300 watt panels and 2 x 4.5 kw batteries cost me \$14,455 to install in July 2019. Since then I have received a total of \$650.44 in feed in tariffs. Not a profit making enterprise you would agree. My intention was to reduce the impact of my power usage on the environment and the battery storage is very useful when power outages from the grid occur. If this proposal is adopted then the appropriate minister should take into consideration at the next election that I VOTE.
