1 Title of Rule

This Rule is the *National Electricity Amendment (Reducing customers' switching times) Rule 2019 No. 14*.

2 Commencement

This Rule commences operation on 19 December 2019.

3 Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

The National Electricity Rules are amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Amendment to the National Electricity Rules

(Clause 3)

[1] Clause 7.8.9 Meter churn

Omit clause 7.8.9(e) and substitute "[deleted]".

[2] Clause 7.8.9 Meter churn

After clause 7.8.9(f), insert:

- (g) *The meter churn procedures must include provisions that enable the installation of a new or replacement metering installation at a connection point as soon as practicable after the transfer of a market load at that connection point has been effected by AEMO.*
