Comments: There needs to be a greater incentive for those installing batteries. An option is to adjust the feedin tariffs so that early morning and late afternoon get higher tariffs and that batteries are recharged in the middle of the day, when the system is awash with excess solar. Taken to its extreme this could mean that those who can not install solar cells eg apartment owners (or eventually renters) could have a battery that recharges in the middle of the day (as well as during the classic off peak times).
