Submission to Introduction of metering co-ordinator planned interruptions rule change draft determination

PIAC welcomes the opportunity to respond to the Australian Energy Market Commission's (AEMC's) draft determination on the rule change proposal to introduce metering co-ordinator planned interruptions.

PIAC reiterates our significant concerns with the rule change as proposed, and supports the alternative draft determination. We agree with the AEMC that the existing framework provides scope to deal with the issues identified, and support the Commission's approach in clarifying the relative roles of Distributors and retailers and providing additional direction to aid more efficient communication, co-operation and information provision. The Draft Determination outlines a sensible and effective response that minimises regulatory complexity and maintains crucial consumer protections. PIAC strongly recommends that the Commission proceed with the rule as drafted.
